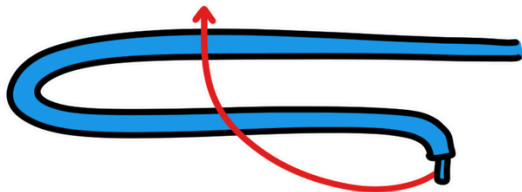
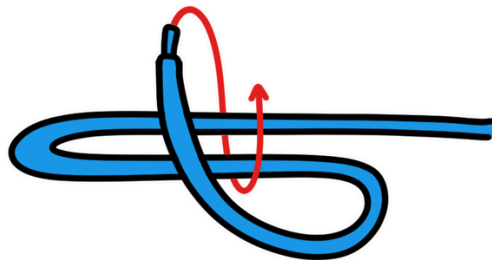


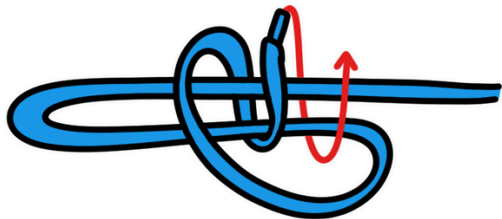
# 1. Uni Knot / Slip Knot



1 Make a U-shaped loop, called a blight. Don't cross the two parts.



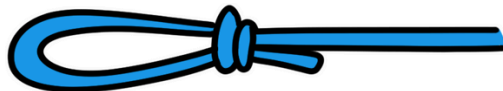
2 Wrap the tag end around the blight



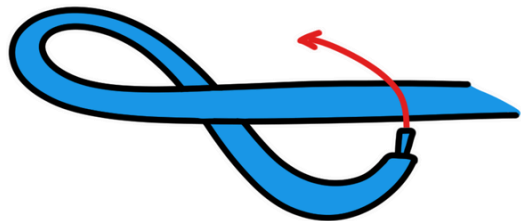
3 Wrap it once more



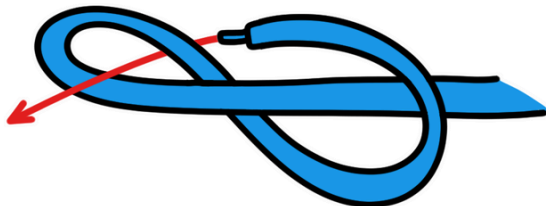
4 Hold the loop and pull the end to tighten



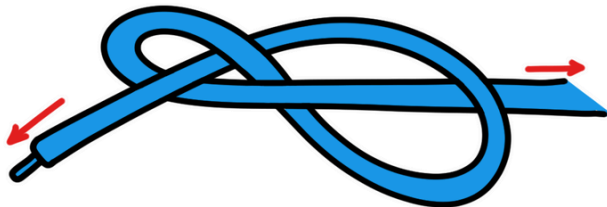
## 2. Figure 8 Knot



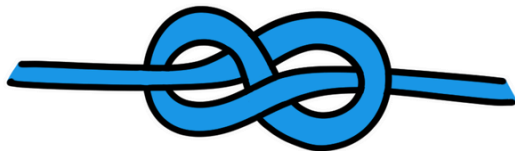
1 Make a loop with an end



2 Now pass the end through it

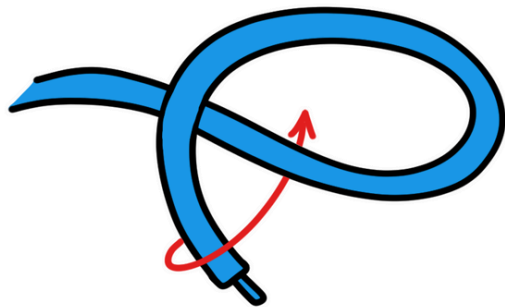


3 Pull both sides to adjust the knot

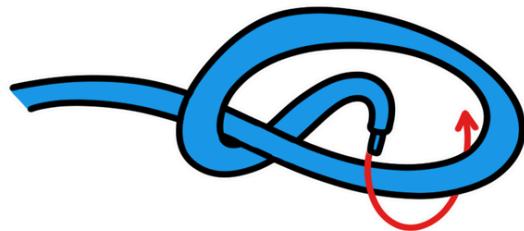


4 The finished knot resembles an "8"

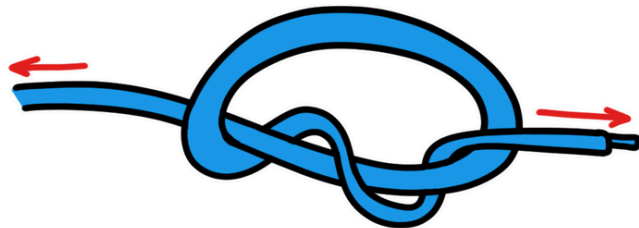
### 3. Double Overhand Knot



- 1 Make a loop and feed the end into it



- 2 Take it outside the loop and pass it through once more

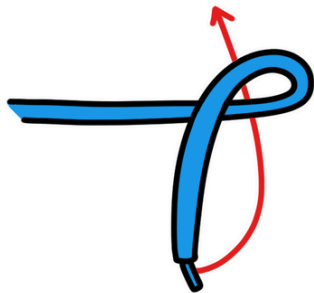


- 3 Pull both ends to tighten

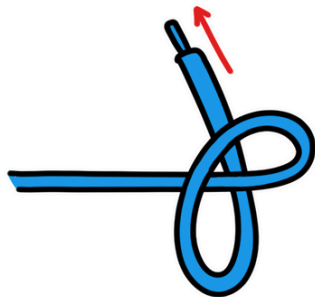


- 4 The two turns come close together

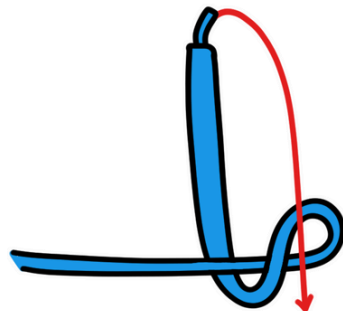
## 4. Stevedore Knot



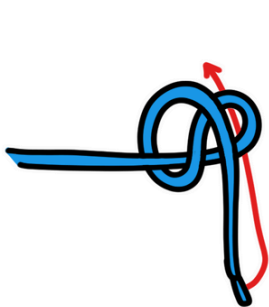
1 Make a loop with the rope



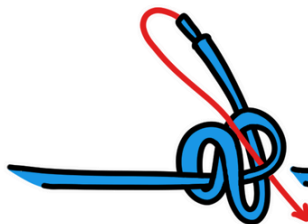
2 Pass the tag end up from behind the loop



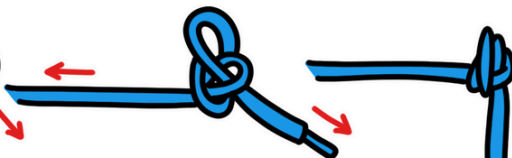
3 Take it down from the front



4 Again pass it up from behind the loop

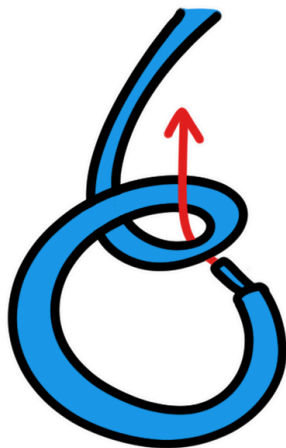


5 Pass it through the loop

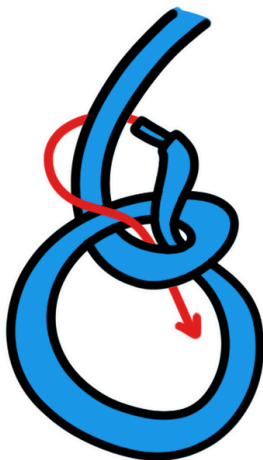


6 Pull both the ends to tighten

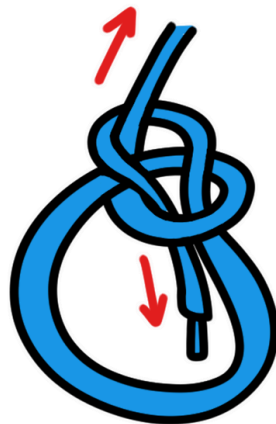
## 5. Bowline Knot



1 Pass the tag end through the rope loop

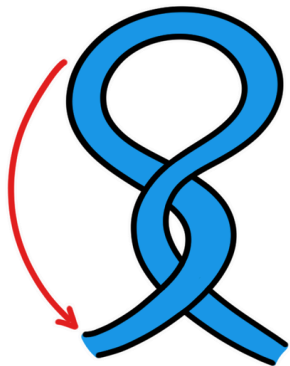


2 Pass it behind the standing part and through the loop again

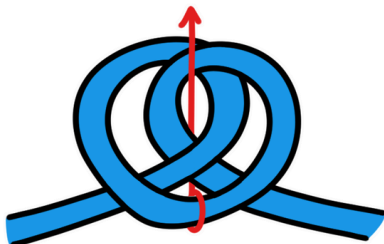


3 Hold the loop and tag end and pull to tighten

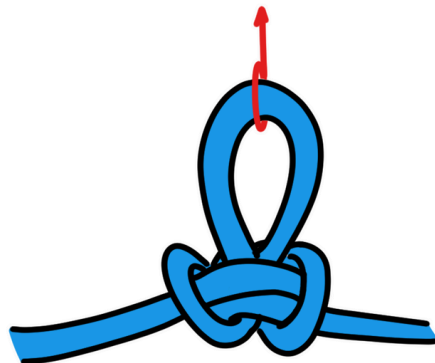
## 6. Butterfly Knot



1 Make a loop like a “B”,  
fold the upper loop down

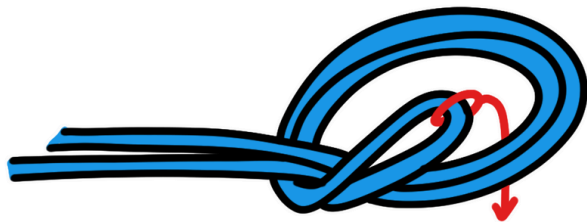


2 Pull it around and pass  
through the lower loop

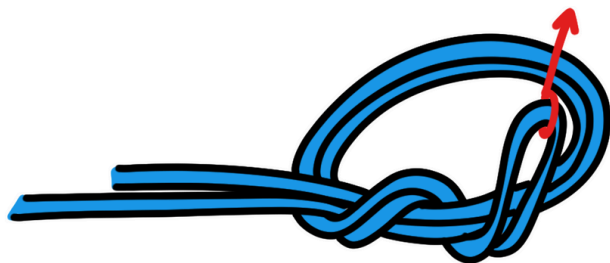


3 Pull all the way up to  
tighten the knot

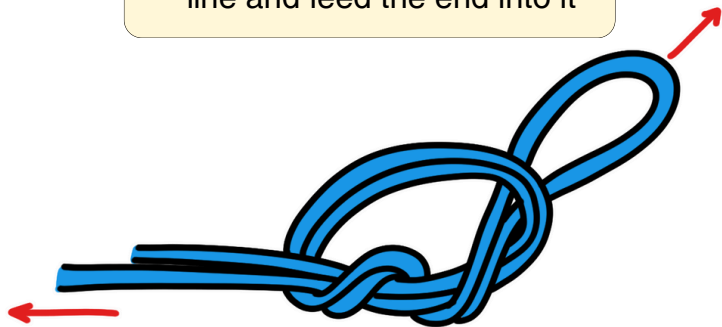
## 7. Surgeon's Loop



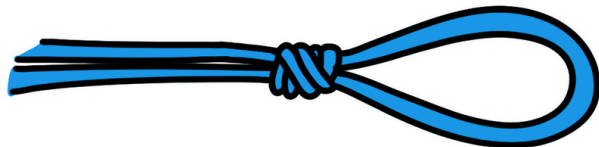
- 1 Make a loop with a double line and feed the end into it



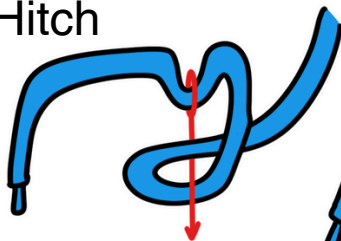
- 2 Pass the end through the loop once more



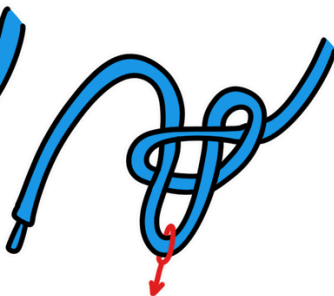
- 3 Take it out of the loop pulling the standing part



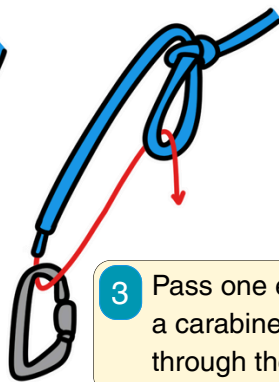
## 8. Trucker's Hitch



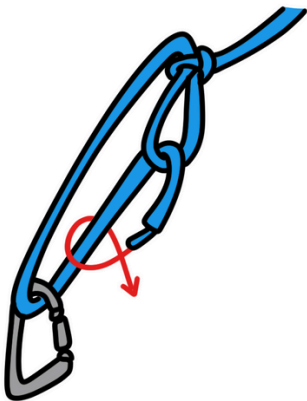
1 Pass the rope through the loop



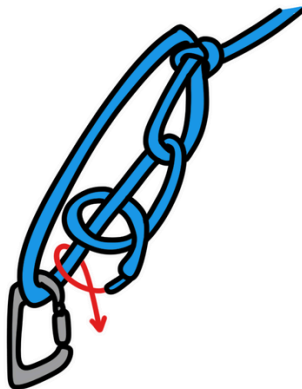
2 Hold and pull to tighten the loop



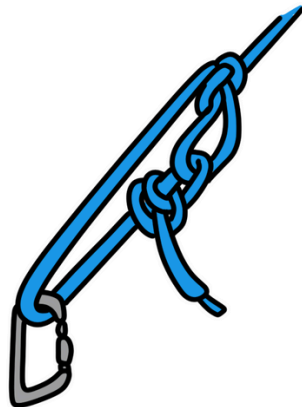
3 Pass one end through a carabiner and pass through the loop



4 Wrap it around the standing part



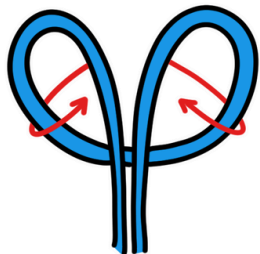
5 Wrap it once more



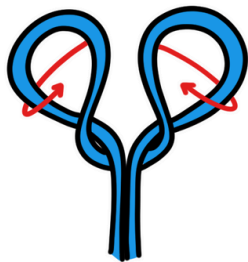
6 Tighten to finish knot



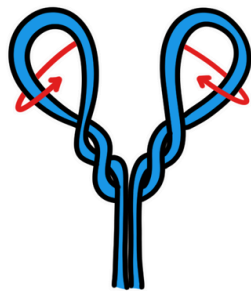
## 9. Cat's Paw Knot



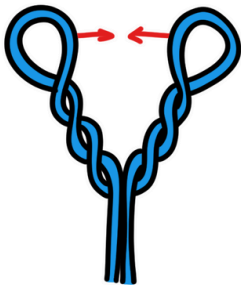
1 Make 2 loops with a rope blight



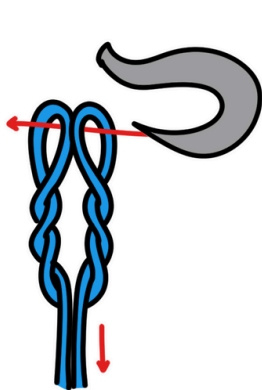
2 Twist them around themselves



3 Do it 3 more times



4 Take the loops close to each other



5 Pass the hook and pull to tighten
